

JAMP Guidelines

JAMP proposes the Guidelines for supply chains that summarize the requirements for communicating information of chemical substances in products by self-directive management of the substances by manufacturers.

chemSHERPA-CI/chemSHERPA-AI

Chemical Manufacturers (Upstream industries)	Communicate the chemical information (substance name in the list of JAMP Declarable Substances and its content) using SDS and chemSHERPA-CI
Parts Manufacturers (Midstream industries)	Communicate the chemical information using chemSHERPA-AI based on the information from SDS and chemSHERPA-CI
	Manage the chemical information contained in the products based on the information from chemSHERPA-AI
